

## Glutolin M22 instant

High quality, readily soluble wallpaper adhesive of methylcellulose and synthetic resin - for wallpapering machines

Instructions for use: Glutolin M22 instant is ideally suited for the safe hanging of vinyl and embossed

vinyl wallpapers, woodchip wallpapers, embossed wallpapers, heavy

wallpapers, fabric wallpapers and other wallpapers coverings. Ideally set for the working with customary papering machines.

**Technical specifications:** Components: Methylcellulose, synthetic resin powder

Density: 0,55 g/cm³ pH-value: approx. 8

Solubility: ready for use in about 5 minutes

Usage: approx. 200 ml/m<sup>2</sup>

Surface preparation: The surface must be dry, firm and free of release agents (dust, formwork oil,

etc.). Remove old peeling wallpaper and distemper using *Glutosolv TA* wallpaper remover. Tidy up cracks, and holes with *Glutofill WF filler interior* or *Glutofill WG Super Bonding Filler*. Pre-treat strongly absorbent, abrasive and

chalky surfaces with Glutogrund Deeply Penetrating Primer LF.

Water soluble contamination of the surface to which the wallpaper is to be applied which may bleed through during papering should be isolated using a sealer spray. To make subsequent removal easier, it is recommended, for washable wallpapers in particular, that the surface to which the wallpaper is to

be applied be treated with wallpaper sizing.

Application: Add Glutolin M22i to cold and clear water (see table), stirring vigorously and

continue to stir briefly. After about 5 minutes, stir vigorously once more.

Apply the wallpaper adhesive with the papering machine or with the brush to the wallpaper, fold the cut strip of wallpaper and hang it after a sufficient curing

period.

Always follow the wallpaper and papering machines manufacturer's instructions.

To improve moisture resistance or for slightly absorbent surfaces is the addition

of 20 % Glutolin BW Wallpaper and border adhesive recommended.

Do not use if the temperature of the room or object to which the wallpaper is to

be applied is less then 5°C.

Clean tools with water immediately after use.

Mixing ratio:

Woodchip wallpapers, non- woven wallpapers, embossed vinyl wallpapers, as well as other heavy wallcoverings	1 : 20	61	approx. 30 m²
